Gamer Garage Sale Policies

Silent Auction Sales

What is the Gamer Garage Sale Silent Auction?

The Gamer Garage Sale Silent Auction provides an opportunity for attendees to sell used games and gaming-related items of significant cost (\$50+) via bids from other attendees at the convention. Highest bid at the end wins! This includes **books**, **puzzles**, and **miniatures**.

Auctioning Items

- To sell items, fill out a Gamer Garage Sale **Silent Auction** Seller Sheet for each item (limit two per seller)
- You **must** have a convention badge to sell items in the Gamer Garage Sale
- Provide a detailed description of the item or bundle that you are selling
- Indicate a starting bid of a minimum \$50, and optionally a "Buy It Now" price
- Prices must be in \$5.00 increments
- Starting bids can be changed after listing (relisted) by contacting staff
- Items can be grouped to sell as a bundle (e.g. set of minis, game w/ expansions, dice, etc.)

Bidding on Items

- It is Caveat Emptor, but if you have questions ask
- We take major credit/debit cards and cash; no checks
- To bid on items, you **must** have a convention badge to buy items from the Gamer Garage Sale Silent Auction
- To bid on an item, bidders place their badge number and bid amount; bids must be at least \$5 above the last bid
- Winning bidders must be present when the auction closes (see below) to complete their payment
- If a winning bidder is not present or is unable to pay, the item will be offered to the next highest bidder

Checking Out and Getting Paid

To check out the Gamer Garage Sale Silent Auction, visit the register any time before 2pm on Sunday. The sale is open from 9am to 6pm, or later if volunteers are available. You can collect your unsold items and get paid for your sold ones. You will receive a Gamer Garage Sale Checkout slip, which you can exchange for cash at the Registration desk.

DEADLINE 1:30 pm Sunday

The Gamer Garage Sale Silent Auction closes at 1:30pm Sunday, and all items **MUST** be picked up by that time. Make arrangements in advance if needed. Items left unclaimed will go to the next highest bidder. If no seller or buyer picks up the item, the item will become the property of RPGKC, organizers of the convention.

15% Commission

Midwest GameFest keeps a 15% commission from your total sales to support the convention.

Example: If the asking price for your sold items totals \$25.00, you will receive \$21.25, as MWGF keeps 15% (\$3.75). Where possible we will round to the nearest quarter.

Fine Print

- All items are sold as-is, and Midwest GameFest takes no responsibility for any missing pieces, damaged, or otherwise undesirable items
- All sales are final and not subject to refund
- No special 'game' mechanics for sellers to adjust price on-the-fly
- The convention staff will determine if an item, bundle of goods, etc. meets the requirements, and reserves the right to accept or turn away items that do not meet the criteria or break the spirit of the sale
- Midwest GameFest takes no responsibility for products damaged, misplaced, or mislabeled at the Gamer Garage Sale; Midwest GameFest watches for shoplifting, sticker swapping, and other mischief but cannot guarantee security for your items
- The purpose of these policies is to enhance security, ensure compliance with the tax code/laws for a 501(c)7 organization, and maintain transparency on all matters as a service to the members of The Role-players Guild of Kansas City, LTD.
